**Boys & Girls Club of Greater Waterbury
2025 Susan K. Nardozzi Scholarship Eligibility**

The Susan K. Nardozzi Scholarship seeks to acknowledge the academic and athletic achievement of a young woman with financial need in grades 9 – 12 who excels in academics and athletics. The young woman must reside in the Greater Waterbury area (giving preference to Club members), including Waterbury, Middlebury, Southbury, Watertown, Woodbury, Wolcott, Prospect, Cheshire, Naugatuck or Beacon Falls and must be attending a private secondary school.

The Susan K. Nardozzi Scholarship encourages young women to thrive in academics and athletics while becoming strong, confident, resilient and prepared for their futures at a private secondary school, day or boarding.

The Susan K. Nardozzi Scholarship will award \$1,000 per year for up to four (4) years of secondary school to a young woman to support the supplemental costs associated with attending a private school, including books and school supplies, uniforms, transportation, dorm supplies or sports equipment.

Applicants must:

- Plan to attend a private secondary school, either boarding or day, for the 2025 -2026 academic year. A copy of the acceptance letter and proof of enrollment must be provided;
- Intend on being a member of at least one (1) team sport at school (one season) during the academic year;
- Submit verification of acceptance to private secondary school attending in the fall;
- Submit one (1) letter of recommendation from a teacher or mentor (recommendation may not come from a relative);
- Submit a 1-2 page essay (no more than 600 words) stating why education is important to her and why she has chosen to attend a private secondary school; and
- Student may be asked to participate in a personal interview.

Prior recipients of the Susan K. Nardozzi Scholarship are welcome to apply. Scholarship will be awarded at the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Waterbury's Annual *Rising Star Awards & Scholarship Dinner*.

Applications must be received by 5:00 pm on Monday, April 7, 2025. Applications may be hand-delivered or mailed to the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Waterbury at 1037 East Main Street, Waterbury, CT 06705 or submitted via email to general@bgcgwater.org (**NOTE "Nardozzi Scholarship Application" in the subject line**). **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

If the recommendation is to be submitted separately, application must clearly state that recommendation is to be submitted separately and by whom.
